Deputy Minister Pam Tshwete to launch Clear Water Pipeline in Rosendal

30 April 2019

The Deputy Minister of Water and Sanitation, Ms Pamela Tshwete, MP, will officially launch Clear Water Pipeline Project in Dihlabeng Local Municipality in Rosendal on Friday, 03 May 2019.

The Dihlabeng LM serves as a Water Services Authority (WSA) and Water Services Provider (WSP) for four towns. The only water resource available for the Paul Roux town area is groundwater which is abstracted from five boreholes in the vicinity of the town. The new project will serve 18 092 households in Fouriesburg, Paul Roux, Rosendal and Bethlehem who previously did not have access to potable water.

The project is divided into three phases that include the construction of Appurtenant Works from Bethlehem Water Treatment Works (WTW) to Paul Roux and New booster pump station at the new Mooivlei pressure break tank. Phase Three will include construction of Water Pipeline and Appurtenant Works from Bethlehem WTW to Fouriesburg/ Mashaeng
