# Why Reporting by Sectors

- 
- An agreement between EU and RSA in order to motivate funding
  - Accountability
  - Ease monitoring and evaluation of performance
  - Comply with PFMA requirements
  - Identify areas of improvement and intervention




## Current status and gaps



- Late reporting jeopardizes the reporting process
- Reports not aligned to the work plan result in difficulty in performance monitoring
- Insufficient information



# Ways to Improve Sector Reporting

- 
- DWA Programme Champions to strengthen report coordination with the Sector Partners
  - Sector Partners to submit reports to DWA Programme Champions at least **5 days** before the reporting deadline to MER unit
  - DWA Programme Champions to monitor the achieved based on planned targets stipulated in workplans
  - The report must include the targets, achieved, challenges, solutions and narrative summary of the key highlights
