

- (2) Whether he will commit to a date on which the bucket system in households will be eradicated; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details? CO189E

REPLY:

1. a) The current number of households still using bucket system is 15 638 households.
b) The estimated cost to fund both the internal services and Bulk infrastructure is R1 049billion.
2. It is anticipated that the Bucket Eradication Programme will be concluded by the end of 2018/19 Financial Year.
